

ORDINANCE NO. 1868

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KANSAS, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES", EDITION OF 2015 WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS AND ADDITIONS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1856

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Russell, Kansas:

SECTION 1. Incorporating Uniform Public Offense Code. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Russell, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code", Edition of 2015, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. One official copy of the Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1868", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the Ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of the code similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. Section 10.5(b) of the Uniform Public Offense Code is hereby supplemented by adding the following subsection:

- (8) To the discharge of a firearm on property zoned Light Industrial (I-1) or Heavy Industrial (I-2) by a business legitimately engaged in ballistic testing with the discharge occurring within a fully enclosed building and the projectile discharged in to catch/stop materials sufficient to stop the projectile.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1856 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication of a summary of the Ordinance in the official city newspaper.
