

RESOLUTION 16-16

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE REGULATIONS AND FEES TO BE COLLECTED FOR THE CITY OF RUSSELL'S COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE MATERIALS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KANSAS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RUSSELL, KANSAS:

CHARGES FOR COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE. In accordance with the definitions and provisions established by Article IV of Chapter VIII to the Code of the City of Russell, Kansas, the following fee(s) and regulations are hereby established for the collection of solid waste as of the Effective Date stated hereinbelow:

I. CHARGES FOR COLLECTION.

Single Family Residential Customers. (Including each unit of a multiple family dwelling containing five (5) or less dwelling units)

- (a) All solid waste shall be placed in Residential Solid Waste Containers as defined in the City Codes in Section 8-402(p) and volumes shall be limited each week to not more than three (3) containers of 32-gallon capacity or less, or one polycart. The charge shall be \$10.35 per month for each dwelling unit and step up to \$10.41 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- (b) A person may contract in advance for the disposal of additional containers at \$6.21 per container per month and the charge will step up to \$6.25 per container per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- (c) Sticker Program. A person may purchase in advance at the city clerk's office a sticker that will permit the person to add an additional solid waste container, not to exceed 32 gallons, to that person's weekly solid waste pickup. The sticker shall be attached to the top of such container in order to be collected by the city crews, at the designated pickup location. The cost is \$2.07 per sticker, which includes collection and disposal fees. The charge shall step up to \$2.08 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- (d) Residential customers that require special loading of refuse on an occasional basis will be charged a fee established by the Public Works Director.
- (e) All new customers are required to purchase a polycart in order to start the service. Current customers who transfer to a new service address after April 1, 2009, are required to purchase a polycart to obtain service at the new address unless there is one provided at that address or the customer has already purchased one from the city and uses it at that address.

Multi-Family Residential Customers. For each residential complex with six (6) or more units, except as requested otherwise by the property owner as provided in Section 8-402 (g), a fee schedule will be charged as for commercial establishments. Such fee will be charged monthly to the landlord or operator of the complex for the commercial dumpster pickups each month. (See commercial dumpster pickup schedule for charges)

Mobile Home Courts and Campgrounds:

- (a) For each residential mobile home court containing more than five mobile home units, the charge shall be \$5.52 month for each mobile home unit, with pickup at one location in a city approved dumpster. The charge shall step up to \$5.55 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- (b) For mobile home courts with individual pickup locations, the charge shall be \$10.35 per month for each unit. The charge shall step up to \$10.41 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.

Commercial Container and Dumpster Customers: For each commercial establishment, the following monthly rate based upon volume of refuse and number of weekly pickups is established:

An additional polycart may be added for \$9.66 per month for one (1) weekly pickup. If more than one (1) weekly pickup then the monthly pickup charge shall be \$9.66 times the number of weekly pickups.

The charge for additional polycarts shall step up to \$9.72 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing. Commercial establishments that require special loading of refuse, on an occurrence basis, will be charged a fee established by the Public Works Director.

Rural Customers for Residential and Commercial Service. Rural customers with electric and water utility service are eligible for sanitation service at a rate thirty percent (30%) above the city rates for residential and commercial charges for collection of solid waste.

Rural Customer Service Rates. For rural customers, as approved by the Public Works Director, the following rates shall be charged for collection services;

A person may contract in advance for the disposal of additional containers at \$8.08 per container per month for residential service and \$12.56 per month for commercial service (does not include an additional two (2) yard dumpster). Stickers for disposal of additional containers, not to exceed

32 gallons, may be purchased for \$2.69 and shall be attached to the top of such container. On and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing the per container rate for residential service will step up to \$8.12, the commercial service rate shall be \$12.63 and the stickers for disposal shall be \$2.71.

II. CHARGES FOR DISPOSAL. The city in providing the service of disposing of garbage and solid waste for the purpose of preventing unsanitary, unsightly, hazardous, unhealthful and dangerous conditions caused by the accumulation of garbage and refuse, shall collect a disposal service charge or fee. The fee is to defray the cost for landfill and related charges and fees.

Disposal Charge for Residential Customers:

- a) A charge of \$4.83 per month for each occupied residence and each unit of a multi-family establishment is established regardless of whether a sanitation fee is charged. This charge shall step up to \$4.86 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- b) A charge of \$2.76 per month for each additional polycart above the original one (1) container allowed will be charged regardless of pickup. This charge applies to persons contracting for disposal of more than one (1) polycart per week. This charge shall step up to \$2.78 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.
- c) A charge of \$1.38 per month for each 32-gallon container will be charged for each container above the original three (3) allowed each week. This charge applies to persons contracting for disposal of more than three (3) 32-gallon containers per week. This charge shall step up to \$1.39 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.

Disposal Charges Commercial Customers. Commercial establishments receiving sanitation service will be charged a disposal fee as follows:

(a) Rates on Effective Date:

Occupied commercial establishments not receiving sanitation service shall be charged \$4.14 per month with a step up to \$4.16 per month on and after the January 5, 2018, utility billing.

Automatic Modification to Disposal Rates for Change in County Landfill Charges. The County presently charges the City \$0.0175 per pound for landfill use. The rate of charge for all customers for disposal charges will automatically be adjusted by a percentage equal to the increase or decrease in the landfill charge made to the City by the County. This adjustment will be made on the first billing cycle following the date of such rate change by the County.

III. EFFECTIVE DATE. The Effective Date for all charges and assessments set forth herein is with the October 20, 2016, utility bill.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event solid waste is presented to the City for collection, or to a City approved contractor, in a quantity or manner not in compliance with the provisions of the City Code or this Resolution the matter shall be referred to the Public Works Director, or his agent, for resolution.
