All new customers after April 1, 2009 will be required to purchase a polycart in order to start the service. Current customers who transfer to a new service address after April 1, 2009, will be required to purchase a polycart to obtain service at the new address unless there is one provided at that address or the customer has already purchased one from the city.

- **Please check for an existing polycart at your new residence.**
- **Once the contract is signed & payment established, the sale is final.**

Polycart Service Information

As of April 1, 2009 a polycarts must be purchased by any new residential moving to the city of Russell. A current resident that transfers from one address to another is also required to purchase a polycart. A sign-up form must be signed to receive a polycart.

A numbered polycart will be assigned to your name and address. If you move, the polycart number will follow you to your City of Russell address.

Place polycart containers in the same location as existing sanitation pick-up containers, either in the alley or front yard on your existing pick-up day.

The city will dispose of your old container if you leave it with your new polycart on pick-up day.

Multiple polycarts will be available to the customer, a reduced rate will be charged for each additional polycart picked up.

No grass clippings or yard waste will be allowed in the polycarts. Polycarts containing these items will not be picked up.
